Based on Data Analysis April 2018 for R, 1, 3, 4, and 5

Year Group	Comments
R	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are 89 children in the cohort; 8 of them are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. One child receives SEN funding. Currently 6 of these children are already achieving a Good Level of Development.
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are 84 children in the cohort; 9 of them are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Only one child receives SEN support. FSM6 children are outperforming Non-FSM6 and All children in all subjects at ARE except in Maths which is slightly lower. FSM6 children are outperforming Non-FSM6 and All children at AARE. Progress of FSM6 children is in line with Non-FSM6 and All children in all subjects. All FSM6 children have made expected progress for this point in the year.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are 87 children in the cohort; 16 of them are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. 6 of the 16 FSM6 children have SEND, 3 of these have an EHCP. Of the 12 remaining, 9 are on track or above in reading (75%); 10 in writing (83%); and 10 in maths (83%). The combined percentage is 75% which is higher than both Non FSM6 children and All children. One of the two children currently not on track is LAC The FSM6 group continue to perform lower than Non-FSM6 in all subjects at 'Age Related Expectations'. Specific interventions will be in place over the coming term to ensure these children make greater progress, particularly in writing increasing the overall attainment of the group.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are 81 children in the cohort; 26 of them are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. 2 children receive SEN support and one has an EHCP. The attainment of FSM6 children is lower in reading than that of Non-FSM6 and All children at ARE and significantly lower in reading. Most children who are not on track are just one point below expected FSM6 children are in line with Non-FSM6 children and All children in reading and writing at AARE. The progress of FSM6 children is now in-line with Non-FSM6 and All children. This continues to be a focus for this term.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are 87 children in the cohort; 26 of them are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. 5 children receive SEN support. The FSM6 group are outperforming Non-FSM6 and All children at Age Related Expectations for reading and writing and are significantly higher in maths. They are outperforming the cohort at Above Age Related Expectations. Progress remains strong across all subjects and is particularly strong in maths with 100% of the group making expected progress. Non-FSM6 children have made increased progress this term and their progress is slightly higher than FSM6 children.
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are 82 children in the cohort; 32 of them are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. 6 children receive SEN support. FSM6 children are outperforming Non-FSM6 and All children in reading and maths at ARE and in all subjects AARE. The progress of FSM6 children is in-line with Non FSM6 children and All children. This needs to be increased in writing to ensure the attainment gap is closed.
