#### Dear Parents/Carers,

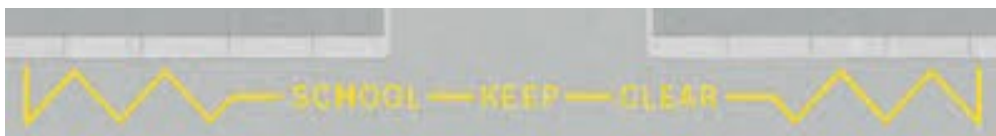

#### Glyndon Neighbourhood Police Team

The Police team have had reports of people stopping/parking on yellow lines/markings outside the school. Parking illegally or causing an obstruction is an offence and will not be tolerated. **Highway Code Rule: 238** You **must not** wait or park on a yellow line during the times of operation shown on nearby time plates. Double yellow lines indicate a prohibition of waiting **at any time**. You must not wait or park or stop to set down/pick up passengers on school markings (see picture below) when signs indicate a prohibition of stopping. Glyndon Police Team will be patrolling the area at school times and people who break the law will be ticketed.

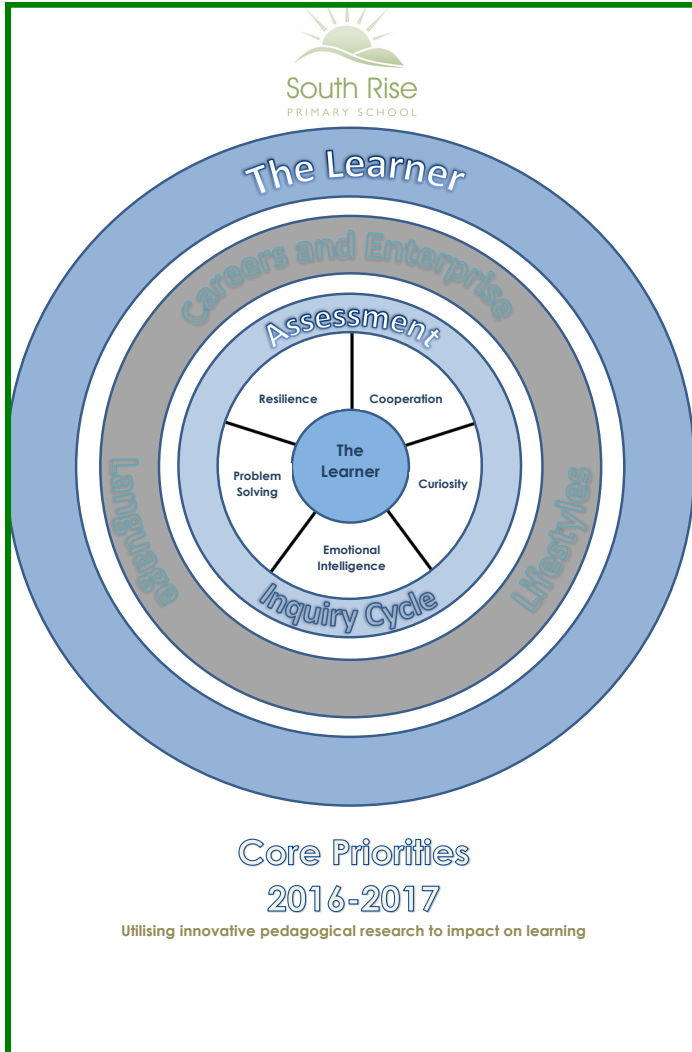

Raising children's aspirations and empowering them to make informed choices about their future

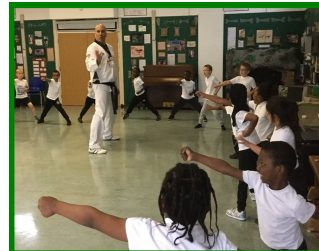
