YEAR 6 RESIDENTAL SCHOOL JOURNEY TO FRANCE 1ST -5TH JUNE 2020

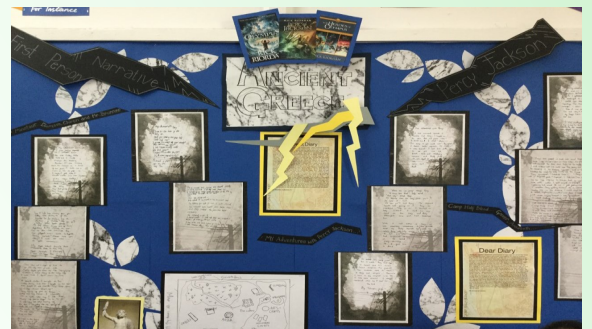

The Compass Parent Forum has now held its first meeting of the academic year. Parent representatives from across our seven schools attended the meeting, hosted at Alderwood Primary School. It was also an opportunity for the Parent Forum to visit our new Compass specialist provision – Phoenix Class. Phoenix Class caters for children with complex social, emotional and mental health difficulties, offering intensive time-limited support, with the aim of successfully returning children to their mainstream school. The Parent Forum discussed what information they felt we should provide to parents of children who may be put forward for a place at the specialist provision. In addition to this, we also discussed the 'Inclusion by Design' document, that once published, will offer guidance to staff on meeting the needs of all of our children.
