Year 2 had a wonderful time finding all the different plants at the Plumstead Common Wildlife Reserve!



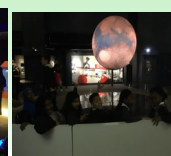
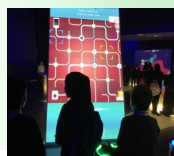
Year 6 National Maritime Museum Trip

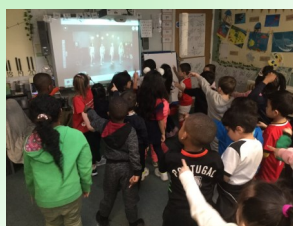
Year 5 Science Museum Trip
