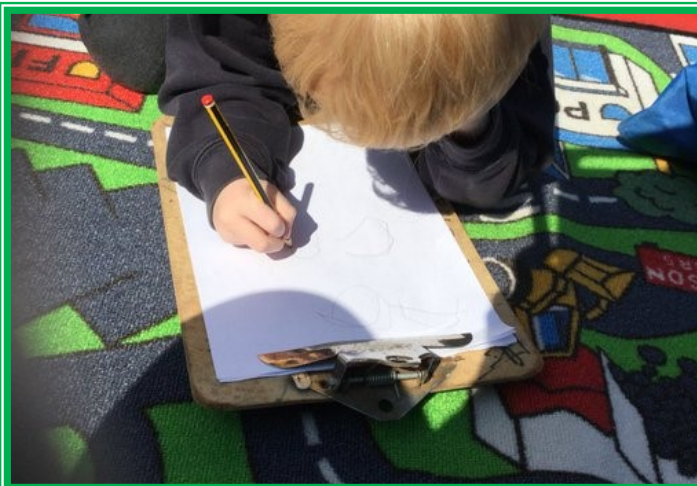
Attendance
