Internet Safety Sessions—Years 5 & 6

To support parents and make sure you are more aware of the dangers, school is running two Internet Safety Sessions for parents and children to attend on Tuesday 31st January at 3:45pm and again at 5:00pm. Please try to attend as these sessions are extremely helpful.

Glass Bottles

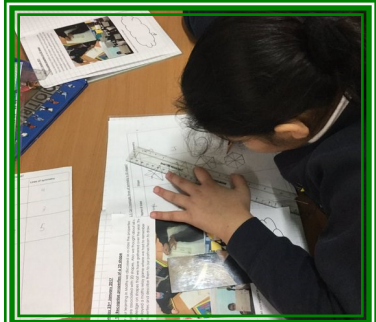
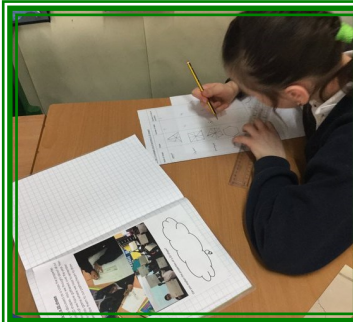
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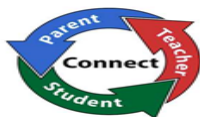
Very well done to 3HC & 5HT who achieved 98.7% attendance the week ending 20th January 2017.
