Whole School Christmas Lunch & Christmas Jumper Day

Whole school Christmas Lunch will be on Tuesday 18th December. If your child normally has a packed lunch but would like a dinner on this day, please let the school office know. The cost of a school meal is £2.60 and there is the choice a turkey dinner with all the trimmings or a vegetarian option. Also on this day, children can come to school wearing their school uniform with a Christmas jumper instead of the school sweatshirt.



Diarrhoea and Vomiting in Children

We are having to send home quite a lot of children with sickness and diarrhoea. These bugs spread very quickly through the school. If your child has an upset stomach then keep them at home for 48 hours until they are clear of all symptoms. Make sure they wash their hands frequently and thoroughly, give them paracetamol for fever and pains plus plenty of fluids to stay hydrated. If in doubt, please contact the school office for advice.

Cold Weather

Now that the weather has turned much colder, can you please ensure your child comes to school wearing a warm waterproof coat, hat, scarf and gloves. On wet days, If your child wears their boots to school they **must** bring their school shoes to change in to. We have a lot of trips coming up this and next term and it is extremely important that your child is wearing warm outdoor wear on these days too.

Free School Meals

We are currently updating our records to ensure that we have captured the details of all families whose children are entitled to receive Free School Meals (FSM). If you receive certain benefits, then your child can receive FSM. If your application is successful, the school will also receive extra Government funding of approximately £1300 per year to support your child's learning (Pupil Premium).
